

Crowns/Bridges/Onlays/Concepts:

**Post-Operative Instructions for
Crowns/Bridges/Onlays/Concepts:**

Initial preparation visit:

1. Avoid chewing hard and/or sticky foods as well as flossing vigorously around the treated tooth. This may dislodge your temporary.
2. Sensitivity on the tooth, gums, or injection site is normal. Motrin (400mg) and Tylenol (1000mg) in combination is a very effective analgesic, and may be taken up to 4 times per day.
3. If you have severe discomfort, or have any problems with the temporary please call us.

“Cementation” visit:

1. The bonding agent (“cement”) used takes 24 hours to fully harden. Be cautious during this time.
2. Sensitivity following this visit is normal, and may last several weeks.
3. If sensitivity persists, is severe, or your bite feels uncomfortable, please call us.
